In 2010, thanks to a strong network of donors including former recipients, CIBPA collected more than \$125,000, allowing them to hand out 34 bursaries.

ers applicants' academic performance and financial need, and on the program's 50th anniversary, a limited number of Meritorious Bursaries will be remitted, based solely on academic achievement.
